## E-Visa for Indian tourists by Japan; application takes 3-5 business days



Japan has introduced an electronic visa (e-visa) for Indian tourists, allowing them to apply for a visa online and eliminating the need for in-person embassy visits. The e-visa is available to Indian citizens who meet certain criteria, including a valid passport, recent photograph, and credit/debit card for the fee. Applications take 3-5 business days, and approval grants a single entry for 90 days from the issue date.

The e-visa aims to attract more Indian tourists, benefiting Japan's tourism industry and cultural relations. To apply, visit the official Japanese e-visa website, complete the form, upload the required documents, and pay the fee. Ensure you have a valid passport, recent photograph, and credit/debit card. Upon approval, print the e-visa and present it at Japanese immigration. The e-visa does not guarantee entry, as the final decision lies with immigration officials.

## **Gujarat Tourism allocates ₹ 200** crores for Special Tourism Zones

Gujarat Tourism Department has allocated ₹200 crores for developing Special Tourism Zones (STZs) in the state, with potential sites like Dholavira, Shivrajpur, Sir Creek, and Banaskantha borders. The Union government's STZ policy offers ₹300 crores for greenfield and ₹100 crores for brownfield STZs in Phase 1, with additional funding if performance-linked parameters are met.

Gujarat's STZs will have unique identities and comprehensive master plans developed as greenfield and brownfield projects. The Union government's guidelines require each STZ to enhance the tourism experience and promote sustainable development. Gujarat's STZs aim to create integrated, modern tourism enclaves in partnership with the private sector.

#### Rough Seas hamper Kannur beach tourism



Kannur, a popular tourist destination in Kerala, has suspended beach tourism activities due to rough seas. The District Disaster Management Authority has temporarily halted beach tourism activities to ensure public safety and mitigate risks.

The Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS) attributes the high waves to a low-pressure system in the Indian Ocean. This highlights the influence of atmospheric phenomena on coastal conditions and the need for increased vigilance and preparedness in coastal regions prone to such events. The rough seas have caused coastal erosion, increased water levels, high tides, and surges, damaging properties, infrastructure, and fishing equipment in Kerala's coastal areas.

Kannur is known for its weaving industry and folk art, Theyyam. The temporary suspension of beach tourism activities may impact tourism, emphasizing the importance of effective disaster management and preparedness measures in coastal areas.




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
