KUMBHALGARH

There is a huge wall surrounding the fort of Kumbhalgarh. This wall is also known as the Great Wall of India. It is built on the Aravalli Hills in Rajsamand District of Rajasthan. It was built in the 15th century by Rana Kumbha who was the Rana of Mewar from the Sisodia Rajput clan.

Rana Kumbha's Mewar stretched from Ranthambore to Gwalior including large tracts of present day Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. Rana Kumbha built 32 of the 84 forts in his empire, of which Kumbhalgarh is the most elaborate and spread over the largest area.

It is also the birthplace of Maharana Pratap the great king and military leader of Mewar, the legendary stalwart who stood up to Akbar and the entire might of the Mughal Empire.

There is very little evidence of the early origins and history of the fort. We should not forget that this land was always facing battles; if there were no invaders like the Afghans and the Ghoris, there were battles between the various Rajput clans.

Kumbhalgarh separated Mewar and Marwar (present day Jodhpur) from each other. It was used as a place of refuge for the rulers of Mewar at times of danger. When Chittor was under siege, Prince Udai, the infant king of Mewar, was smuggled here in 1535. Prince Udai later succeeded to the throne and was crowned the king of Udaipur.

Rajendra Singh, a fervent loyalist of the fort, has many

interesting tales to tell. Raiders like Ahmad Shah II of Gujarat, Mahmud Khalji and Shahbaz Khan, Akbar's general attacked the fort repeatedly, over a period of 10 years, but found their efforts futile.

In an act of vengeance Ahmed Shah destroyed some of the beautiful temples. There were more futile attacks by Mahmud Khalji. 1576 was the only time Kumbhalgarh Fort went into the hands of enemies that too because of water shortage.


One of the more interesting bits he spoke of and which can be verified by visitors is that the fort is not visible from the ground level and that is true!

After the battle of Haldighati where the Mughals lost to the Rajputs, Shahbaz Khan, who was Akbar's newly appointed general, was asked to lay siege to the fort to capture Maharana Pratap. I am told that Shahbaz Khan did succeed although


locals say that Maharana Pratap escaped into the Aravalli Hills to fight another day. His horse Chetak is supposed to have jumped from the highest ramparts of the fort to take his master to safety.

There were additions made to the Kumbhalgarh fort by the Maharanas of Mewar, but the original structure built by Maharana Kumbha remains. The residential buildings and temples are well-preserved. The residential areas are small compared to Chittorgarh, as the royal families lived in this fort only for short spells.

The highest point in the fort is the Badal Mahal and the terrace there. At the highest point it is 3700 feet above sea level. Behind the Badal Mahal is a reserve forest where tourists can go on jungle safari and spot leopards, jackals and hyenas besides wild boar.

NEARBY ATTRACTIONS

eelkanth Mahadev Temple is a famous Shiva temple located inside the Kumbhalgarh Fort next to Vedi Temple Complex. It is an ancient temple and has a six feet high Shivling which is made of stone. Shiva is the reigning deity of the fort and is very popular with the locals also. King Rana Kumbha used to worship this deity too.

Kumbhalgarh Wildlife Sanctuary is famous for, that is rarely found elsewhere. Apart from the wolf, it also houses various varieties of endangered and rare animal species and almost 200 different species of birds.

Ranakpur Jain temple is a must-visit location for Architecture buffs.

Safari is closed for three months in the rainy season.



How to get there: Indigo and Spice Jet have direct flights from various cities to Udaipur. Book a taxi for Kumbhalgarh and enjoy the sights.

In 2013, at the 37th session of the World Heritage Committee held in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, Kumbhalgarh Fort, along with five other forts of Rajasthan, was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site under the group Hill Forts of Rajasthan.



ANGKOR WAT The 8th Wonder of the World

ngkor Wat is a true marvel of the ancient world, a sprawling heritage site that has captivated travellers for centuries. In 2023, this temple was named the 8th Wonder of the World (unofficially) by UNESCO, beating Italy's Pompeii. As the largest religious monument on Earth, it is a must-visit destination for anyone exploring the rich cultural heritage of Cambodia. The temple was originally constructed in the 12th century as a Hindu temple, before later being converted to a Buddhist temple. The sheer scale of the complex is awe-inspiring - it covers an area of over 500 acres and was once the centre of the powerful Khmer Empire. Archaeologists believe the city of Angkor itself may have had a population of up to one million people at its peak, making it one of the largest pre-industrial cities in the world.

At present, in Bihar's East Champaran district, a monumental masterpiece is being constructed- the Viraat Ramayan Temple. Begun in June 2023, this three-storey temple is taking shape by drawing inspiration from three renowned temples: the Angkor Wat temple in Cambodia, the Ramanathaswami temple in Rameshwaram, and the Meenakshi

Getting There

The best time to visit is during the dry season from November to February, when the weather is cooler and less humid. Arriving at sunrise is highly recommended, as you can witness the monument bathed in the soft, golden light of dawn.

Be prepared for crowds, as this temple is a popular tourist destination in Southeast Asia. When visiting, it's important to dress appropriately by covering your shoulders and knees. Comfortable walking shoes are a must, as you'll be doing a lot of exploring on foot. It's also a good idea to bring a light raincoat, as the weather can be unpredictable.




