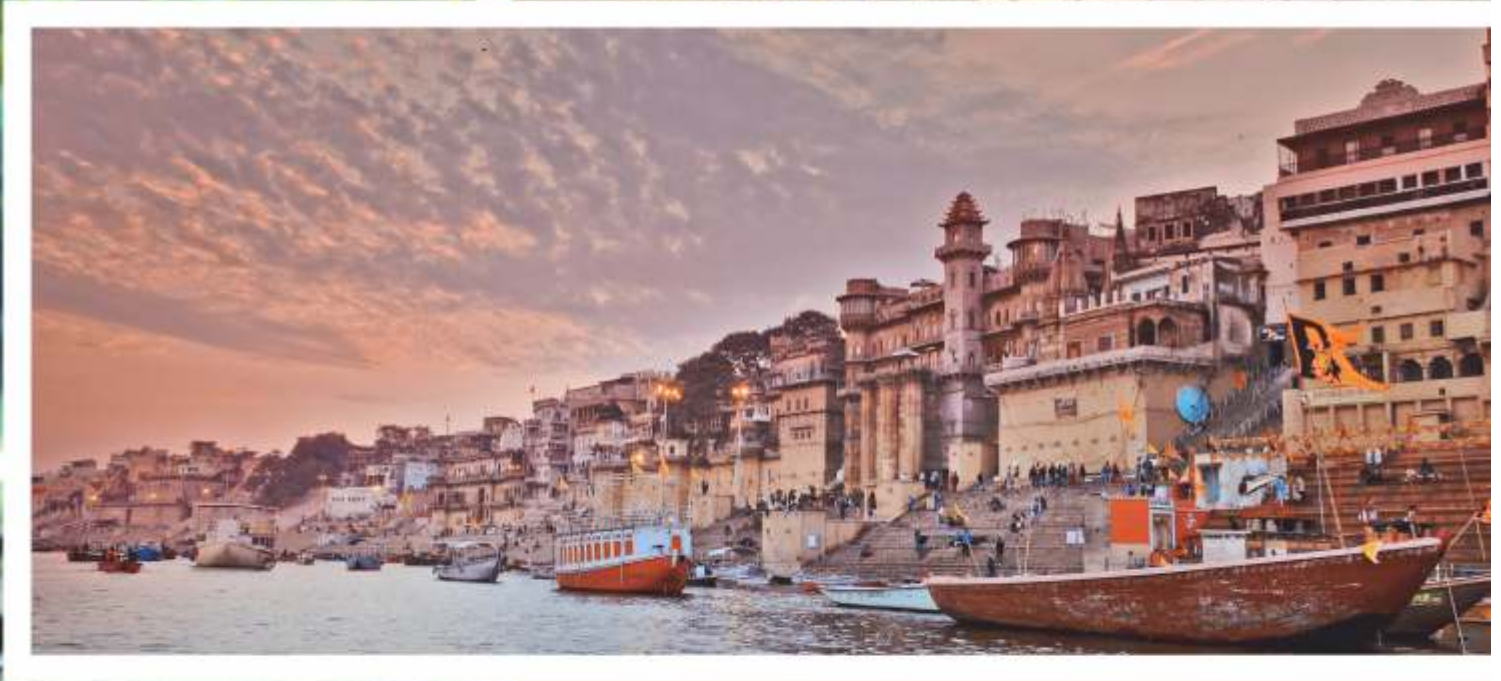
In Karnataka, Coorg's plantation

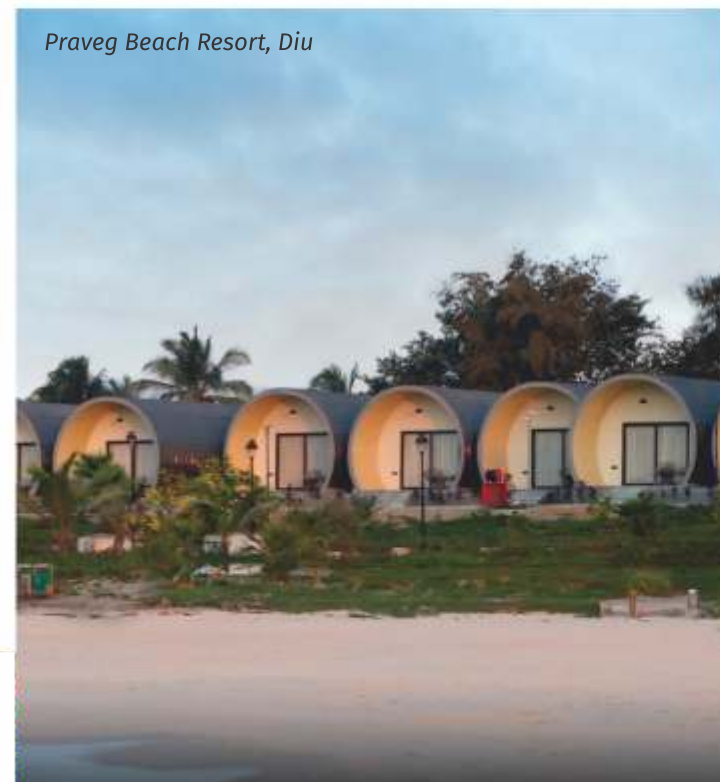

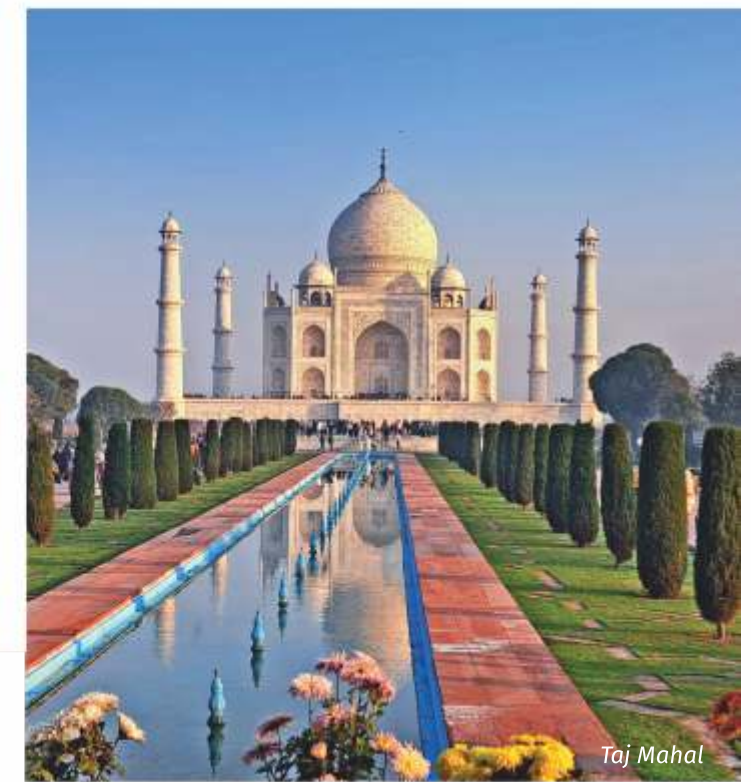

## A travel guide structured by landscape

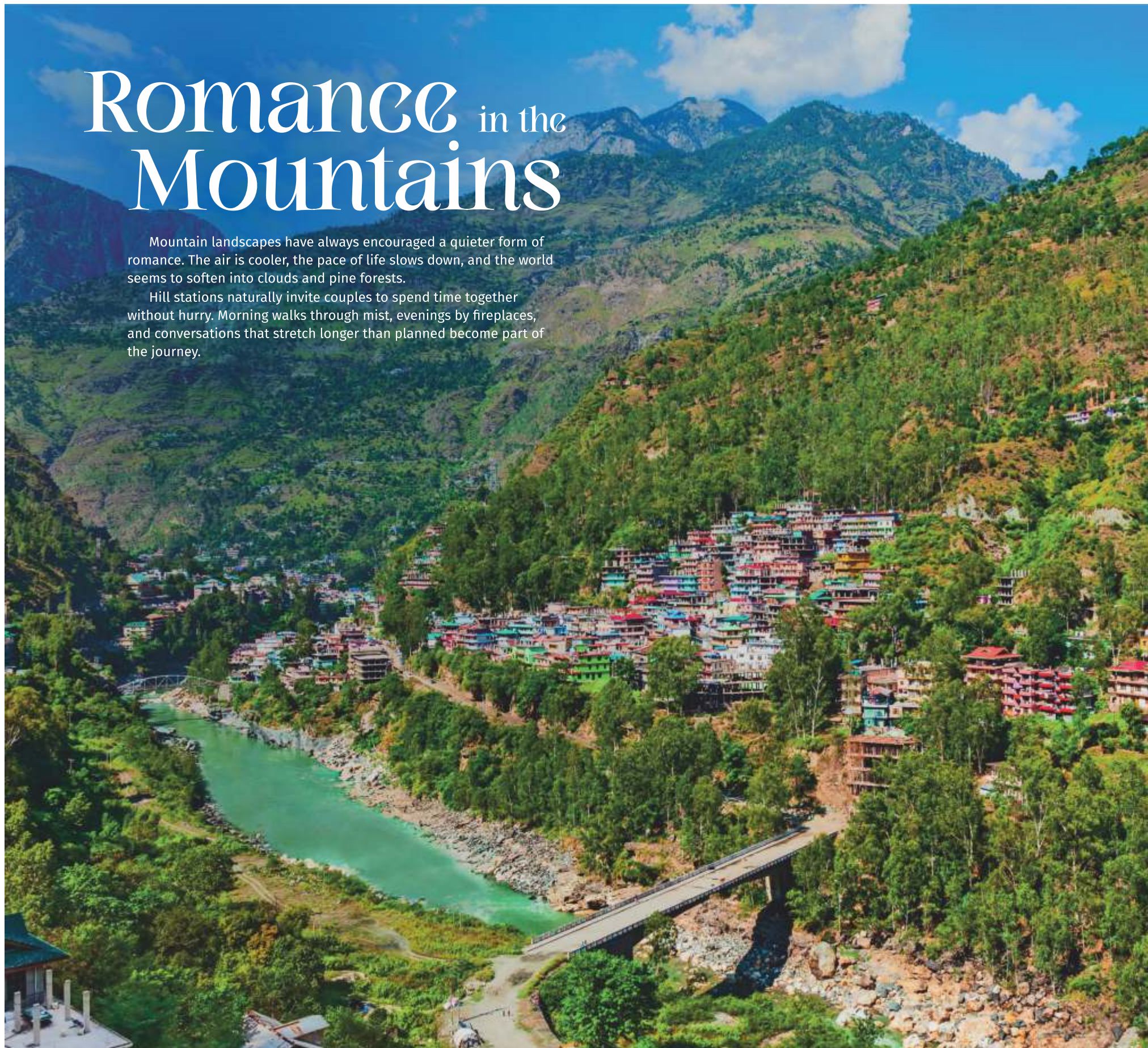

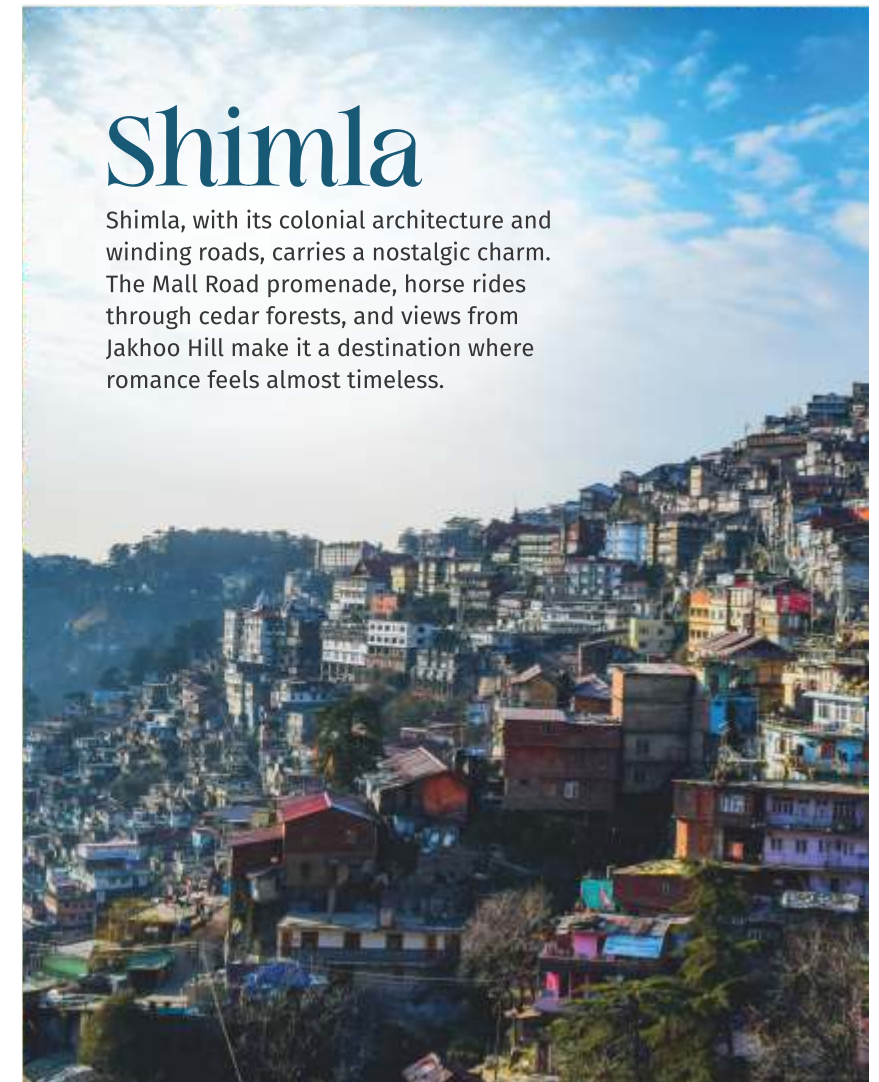
## Manali

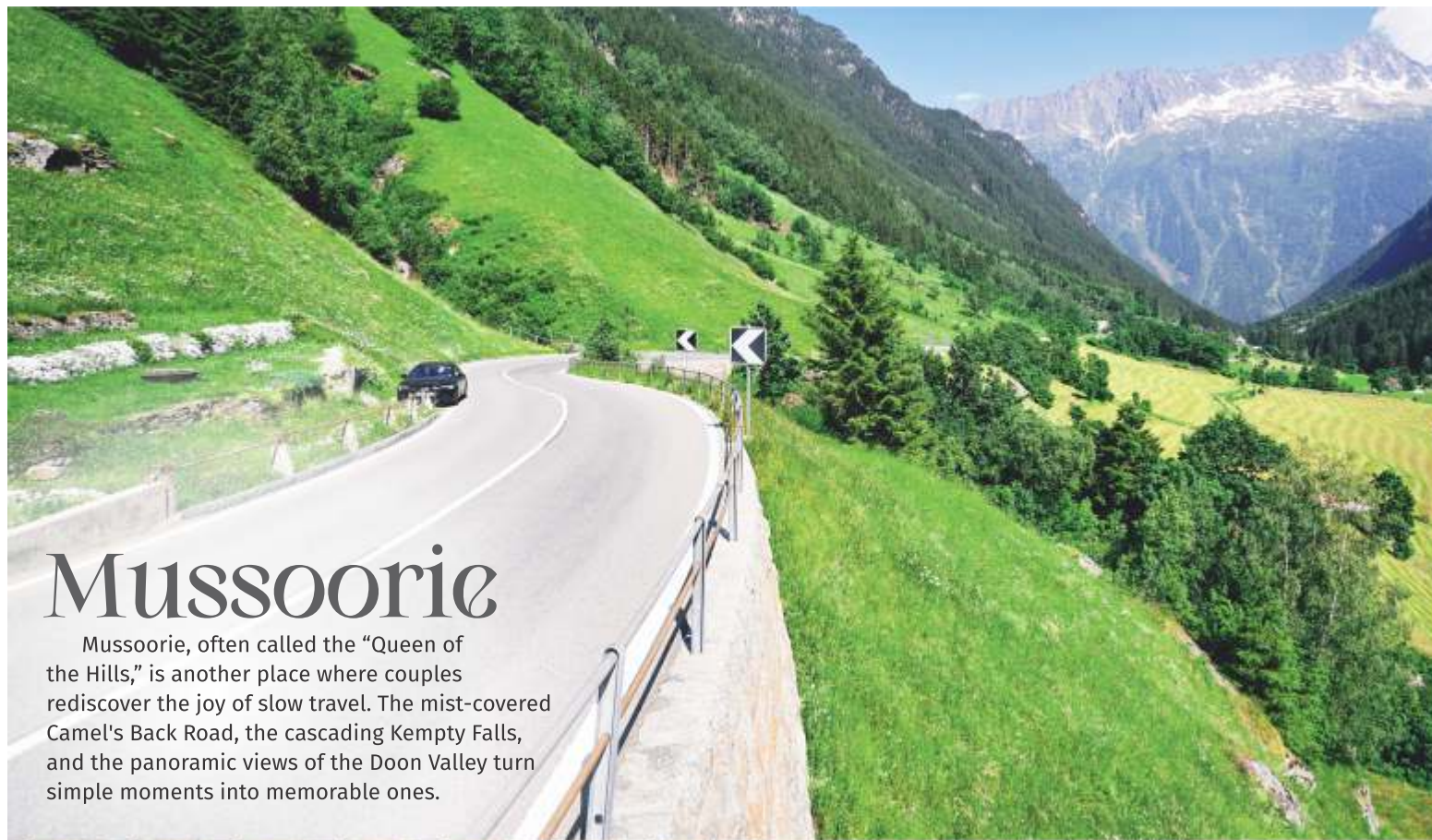

## Shimla

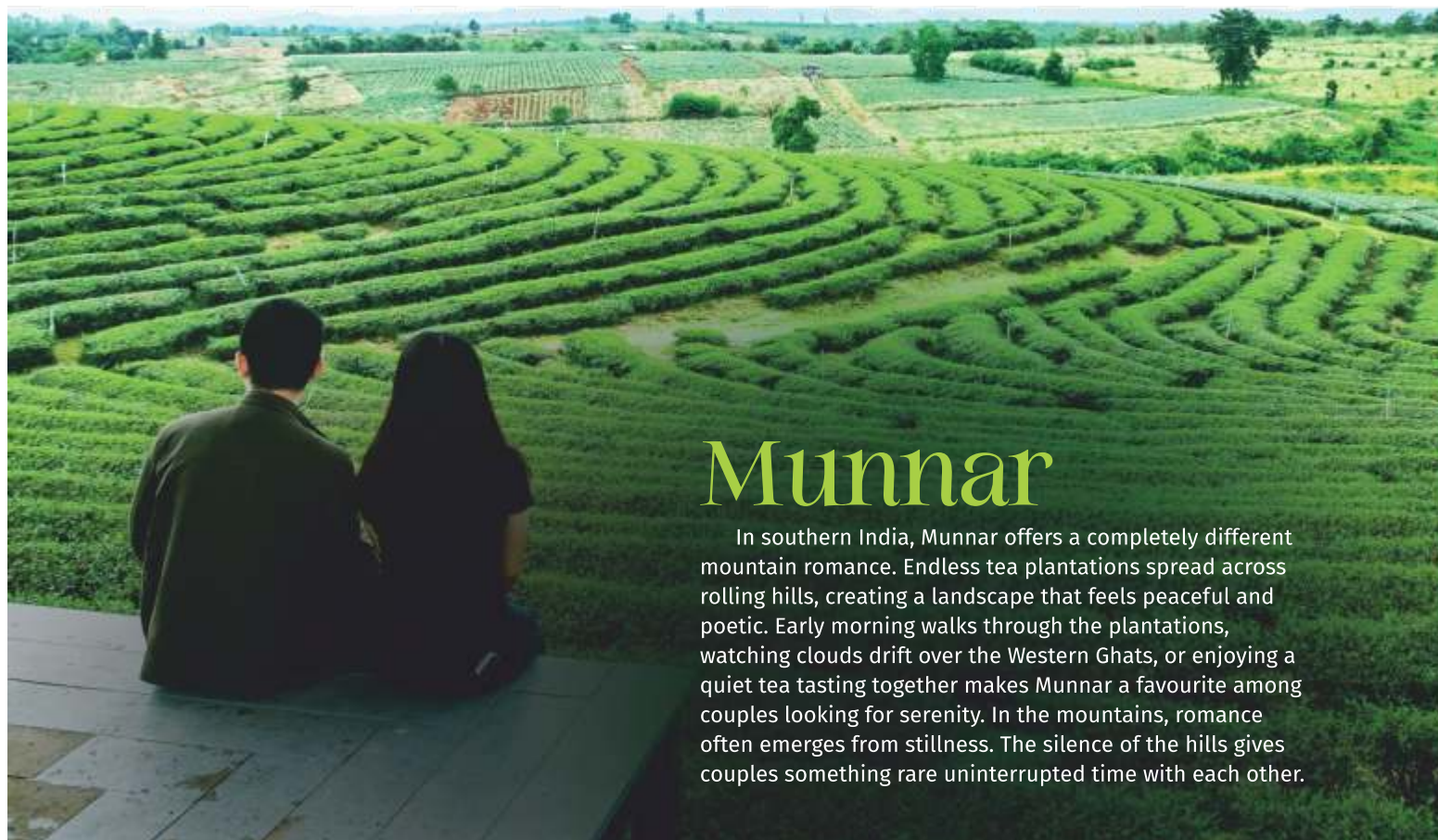

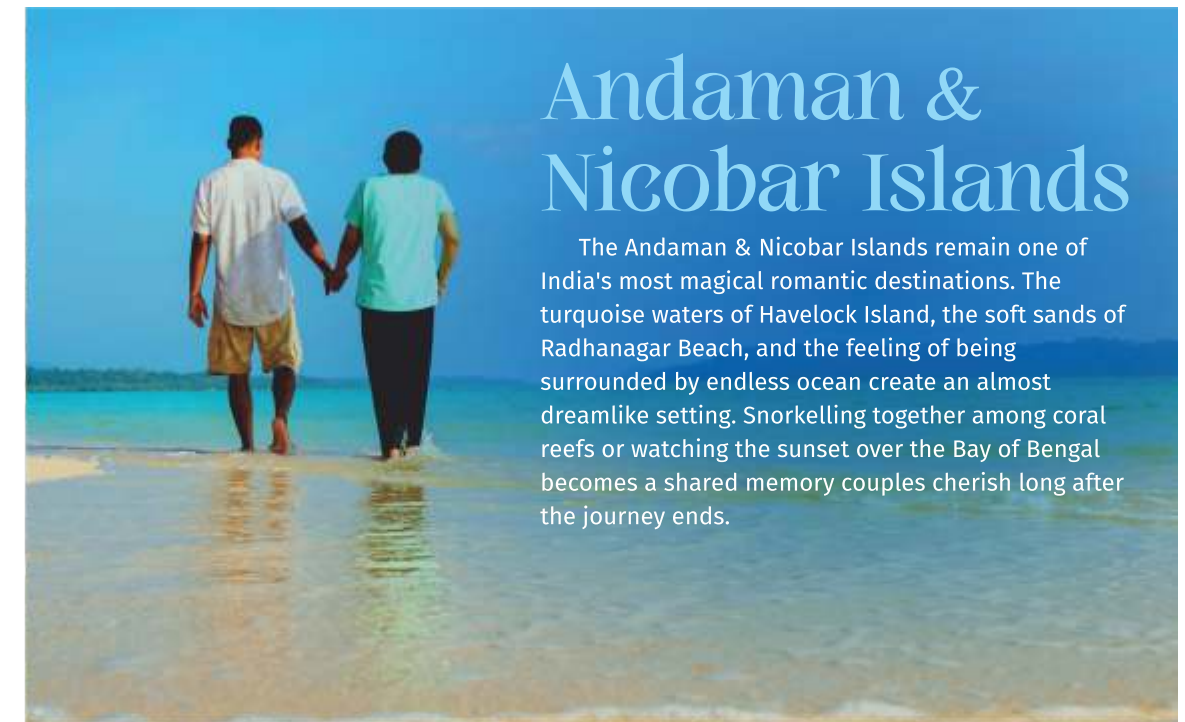

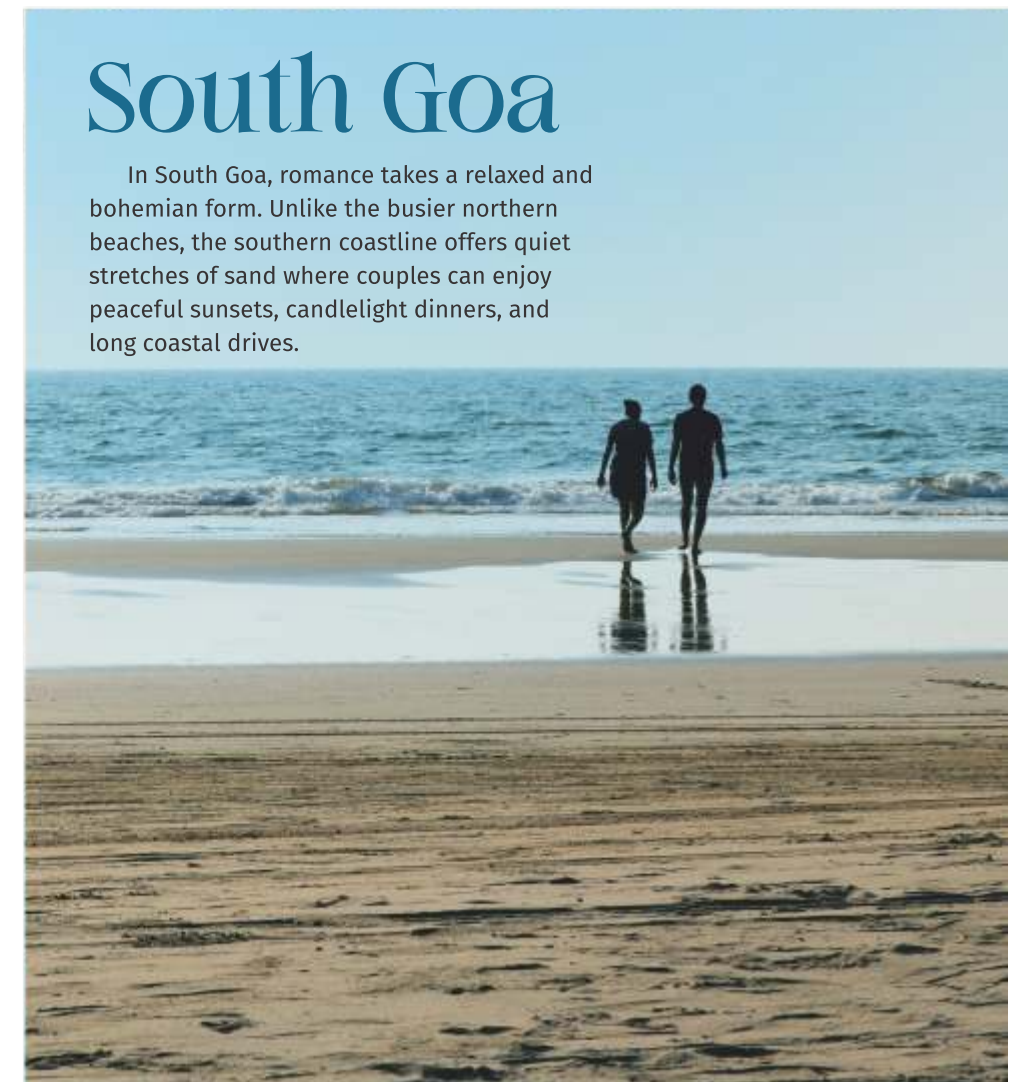


# Andaman & Nicobar Islands

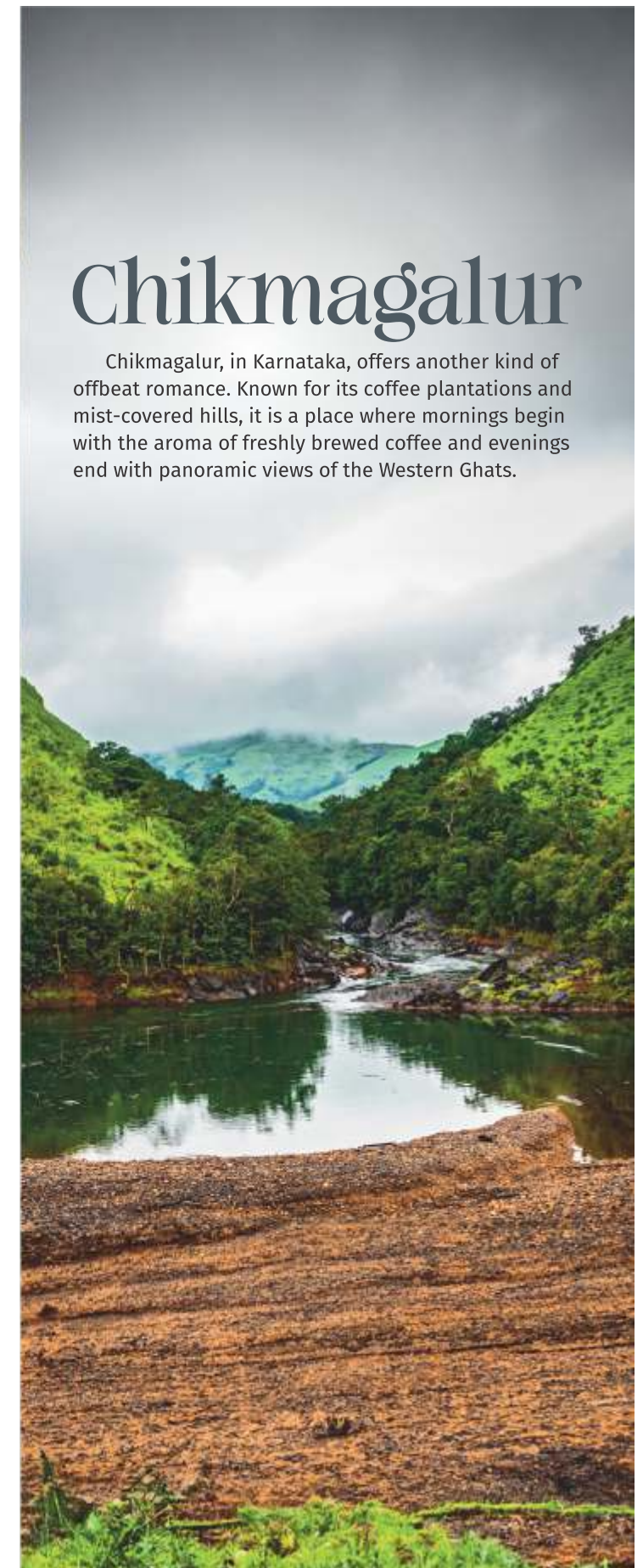

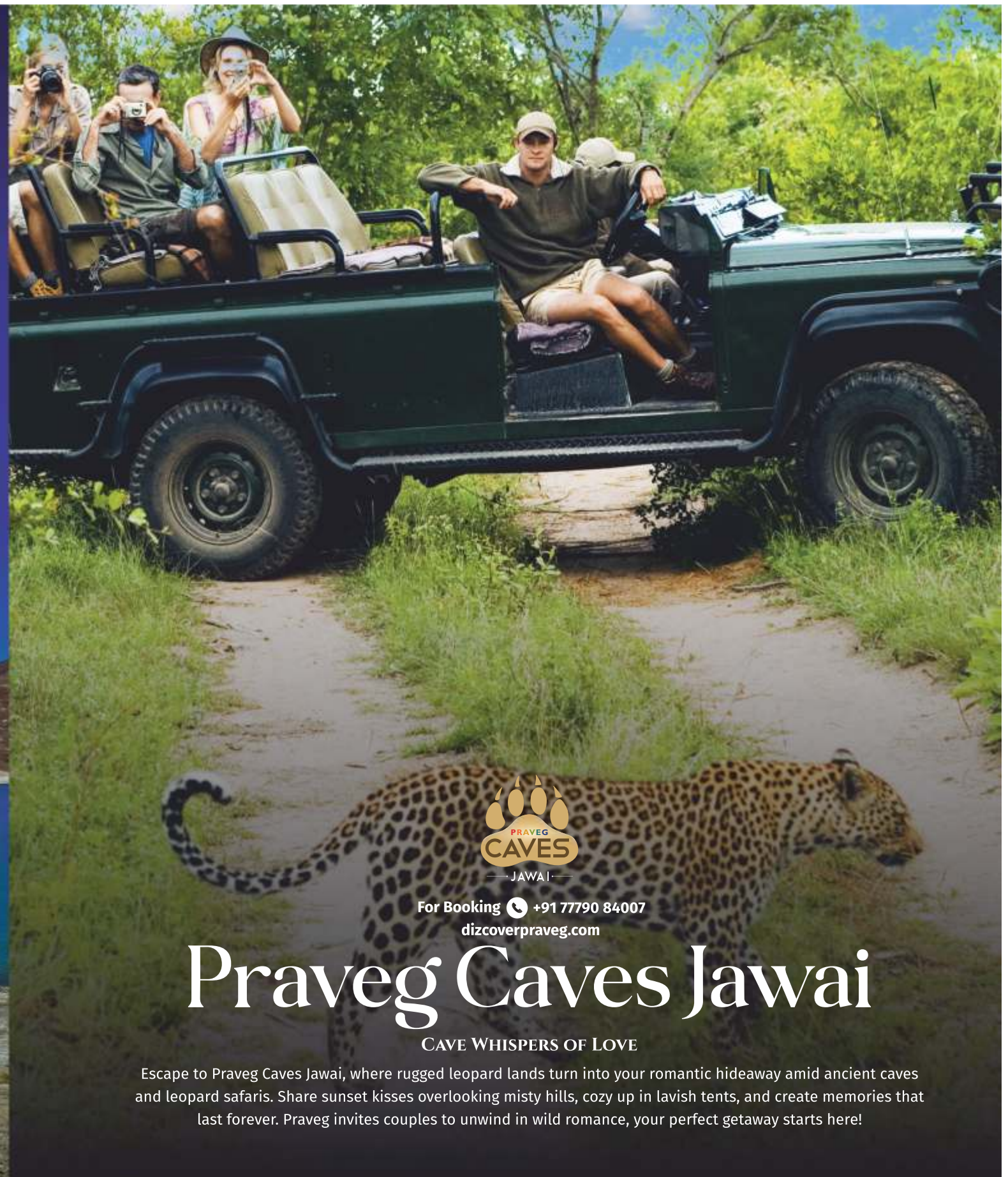

Further south, the cc are now emerging as an exciting desti-nation for cacao cultivation. Several farms have begun growing cacao alongside coffee, offering visitors the chance to see how chocolate begins its journey from bean to bar.

Walking through a cacao plantation, learning about fermentation and roasting, and tasting fresh chocolate straight from the source creates a deeper appreciation for the craft.

For couples, the experience offers more than just flavour, it offers discovery. And sometimes romance grows stronger when two people learn something new together.

# *The Romance of* **SLOW JOURNEYS**

Love rarely rushes. It grows in pauses, in glances through windows, in conversations that unfold slowly like landscapes passing by. In a world obsessed with speed—flights, expressways, instant messages—train journeys still carry the quiet poetry of time. They invite couples to slow down, to watch the country glide past, and to rediscover the simple intimacy of shared travel. India, with its diverse geography and railway heritage, offers some of the most romantic train journeys in the world. From royal luxury to misty mountains and coastal panoramas, these journeys transform travel into a shared memory—where the rhythm of the rails becomes the rhythm of romance.



## **Palace on Wheels Royal Romance on Rails**

If romance had a royal address, it would probably be the Palace on Wheels. Launched on 26 January 1982, this luxury train was conceived to recreate the regal travel experience of India's princely rulers. Operated jointly by Indian Railways and the Rajasthan Tourism Development Corporation (RTDC), it remains one of India's most iconic luxury train journeys. The train departs every Wednesday from Safdarjung Railway Station in New Delhi and takes travellers on a 7-night, 8-day journey across the heritage cities of Rajasthan and Agra. The itinerary typically includes Jaipur, Sawai Madhopur (Ranthambore), Chittorgarh, Udaipur, Jaisalmer, Jodhpur, Bharatpur and Agra before returning to Delhi. The train features 14 guest coaches inspired by former princely states, each decorated with royal motifs and equipped with modern comforts. In total, the train accommodates roughly 80–82 guests in deluxe and super deluxe cabins, along with two fine-dining restaurants, a lounge bar, spa services and personal attendants. Prices vary depending on the season and cabin category.

For Indian travellers, fares typically begin around 70,000–80,000 per person per night for double occupancy, while premium suites cost significantly more. Booking can be done through the official website or authorised luxury train operators, with journeys usually operating between September and April. But the real luxury is not only the décor or cuisine. It is the experience of watching Rajasthan's deserts, forts and sunsets unfold outside your cabin window while you sip tea together. For couples, the Palace on Wheels transforms travel into a royal courtship—where every mile feels like a page from a timeless love story.

## Love Between Sea and Mountains

If one railway line captures India's dramatic geography, it is the Konkan Railway. Stretching along the western coast between Roha in Maharashtra and Thokur near Mangaluru in Karnataka, the route runs for about 741 kilometres, connecting Mumbai with Goa, coastal Karnataka and Kerala.

The Konkan Railway Corporation officially opened the line in 1998, after one of the most challenging railway construction projects in India. The route passes through the rugged Western Ghats and features over 2,000 bridges and around 90 tunnels, making it an engineering marvel as well as a scenic masterpiece.

Unlike luxury tourist trains, the Konkan experience lies in its accessibility. Regular passenger trains such as the Mandovi Express, Matsyagandha Express and Jan Shatabdi services travel along this route daily.

The journey reveals a constantly changing landscape: emerald-green hills, waterfalls in the monsoon, sleepy fishing villages, and glimpses of the Arabian Sea appearing between coconut groves.

Ticket prices vary widely depending on train class—from ₹500–₹3,000 or more for long-distance journeys between Mumbai and Goa or Mangaluru. Tickets can be easily booked through IRCTC or Indian Railways reservation counters.

What makes the Konkan route particularly romantic is its unfiltered authenticity. There are no elaborate luxury cabins here—only open windows, salty sea breeze and the quiet companionship of travel.

For couples, the Konkan Railway offers romance in its simplest form—two people watching the sea and mountains meet while the train carries them gently along the coast.

## Love in the Misty Hills

Few train journeys in the world feel as nostalgic as the Darjeeling Himalayan Railway, affectionately known as the Toy Train. Built between 1879 and 1881, this narrow-gauge railway connects New Jalpaiguri to Darjeeling, covering a distance of about 88 kilometres through the eastern Himalayas.

Operated by the Northeast Frontier Railway of Indian Railways, the line climbs from the plains to the hill town of Darjeeling at an altitude of over 2,200 metres, negotiating sharp curves, zigzag reverses and famous loops such as the Batasia Loop.

The journey typically takes 7 to 8 hours, moving slowly through tea gardens, pine forests and colonial hill settlements. The train's small blue carriages and vintage steam engines have become symbols of India's railway heritage, earning the route a place among the UNESCO World Heritage Mountain Railways of India.

Several travel options exist for tourists. The full journey from New Jalpaiguri to Darjeeling offers the complete experience, while shorter "joy rides" between Darjeeling and Ghum provide a two-hour scenic excursion.

Tickets can be booked through the IRCTC website or Indian Railways booking portals, and fares vary depending on whether one chooses diesel or heritage steam services.

Yet statistics cannot fully capture the charm of this journey. As the train crawls past tea plantations and mountain villages, the outside world seems to slow down with it.

For couples, the Darjeeling Toy Train is a gentle reminder that love, like mountain railways, climbs steadily and beautifully when it moves slowly.



## Conclusion Why Slow Journeys Matter

In relationships, as in travel, speed often steals the beauty of the journey. Flights may take you across the country in a few hours, but trains allow something deeper: time to talk, to observe, and to simply be together. 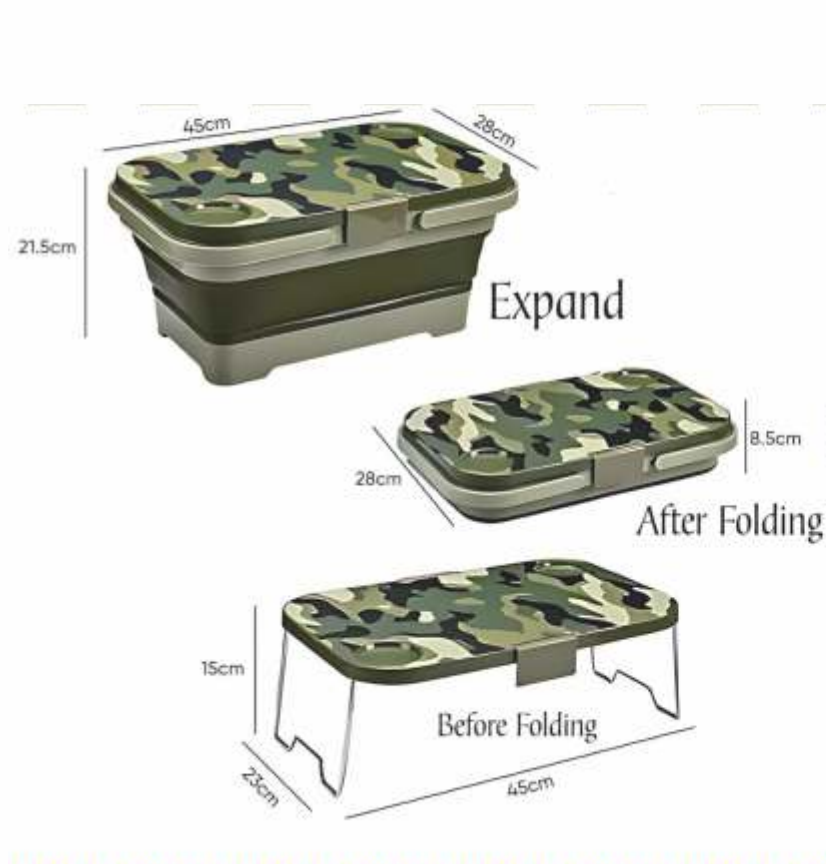

- 1 tbsp powdered sugar
- ½ tsp vanilla essence



#### For the Crumb Layer

- ¾ cup biscuit crumbs (digestive or graham crackers)
- 1 tbsp sugar
- 4 tbsp melted butter

#### For Garnish

- Fresh strawberries

#### Method

1. In a medium bowl, combine mascarpone cheese and ¾ cup strawberry compote. Mix gently until smooth. Cover and keep it in the refrigerator for about 30 minutes.
  - Add 2 teaspoons mascarpone mixture and smooth gently.
  - Add 1½–2 teaspoons strawberry compote or jam.
2. In another chilled bowl, add fresh cream, powdered sugar and vanilla essence. Beat the mixture until soft peaks form. Keep the whipped cream chilled until required.
3. In a small bowl, mix biscuit crumbs, sugar and melted butter. Stir until the mixture looks like moist sand.
4. Take 6 small serving glasses and start layering the parfait:
  - Add 2 teaspoons biscuit crumb mixture at the bottom and press lightly.
5. Repeat the layers once again with crumbs, mascarpone mixture and strawberry compote.
6. Top each glass with whipped cream.
7. Refrigerate the parfaits for 15–30 minutes before serving. Garnish with fresh strawberries and enjoy.

This colourful dessert offers the perfect balance of creamy, fruity and crunchy flavours in every spoonful.

## Rose & Pistachio Kulfi

### *A Royal Summer Kulfi*

Rose & Pistachio Kulfi is a rich and aromatic Indian frozen dessert that brings together the delicate flavour of rose with the crunch of pistachios. Made with thickened milk and a few simple ingredients, this kulfi offers a creamy texture and refreshing taste, perfect for warm Indian summers. The addition of gulkand and rose syrup gives the dessert a pleasant floral aroma, while pistachios add a nutty richness. Served chilled, this traditional treat makes a delightful ending to any meal.

#### Ingredients

- ½ litre full-fat milk
- 3 tbsp gulkand (rose petal jam)
- 3 tbsp rose syrup (Rooh Afza or similar)
- 3 tbsp condensed milk
- 3 tbsp cornflour
- 4 tbsp pistachios, finely chopped
- 1–2 tbsp dried edible rose petals (optional)



#### Pro-tips

- Using the same process you could add any flavour to your kulfis. Add flavors of your choice.
- We have not added any sugar/sweetener, since the gulkand, rose syrup and condensed impart enough sweetness for my taste. You may add any sweetener of your choice, if you wish.

#### Method

1. Take 3 tbsp milk in a small bowl and mix with cornflour to make a smooth slurry. Keep aside.
2. Pour the remaining milk into a pan and bring it to a boil. Cook on medium heat, stirring occasionally, until the milk reduces to about half.
3. Add condensed milk and mix well. When it begins to boil again, add the cornflour slurry and cook until the mixture becomes slightly thick and creamy.
4. Remove from heat and stir in rose syrup, gulkand and chopped pistachios. Allow the mixture to cool to room temperature.
5. Pour the mixture into kulfi moulds or small cups and cover with foil or lids.
6. Freeze for 8 hours or overnight until completely set.
7. To remove the kulfi, dip the mould briefly in room-temperature water and gently pull it out.
8. Garnish with rose petals and pistachios before serving.

This fragrant kulfi is a perfect dessert for summer evenings or festive occasions.

# Dark Chocolate with Sea Salt

*Sweet Meets a Hint of Salt*

If you love rich desserts, dark chocolate fudge with sea salt is a treat you must try. This simple recipe needs only a handful of ingredients and very little cooking skill.

## Ingredients

- 250 g dark chocolate chips
- 150 g sweetened condensed milk
- 1-2 tbsp unsalted butter
- ½ tsp cinnamon (optional)

## Pro-tips

- If you prefer a slightly less sweet fudge, add 1 tsp instant coffee powder after melting the chocolate mixture. Mix it well into the warm chocolate and condensed milk.
- You may add 1 tbsp hot water to dissolve the coffee powder if required.

## Method

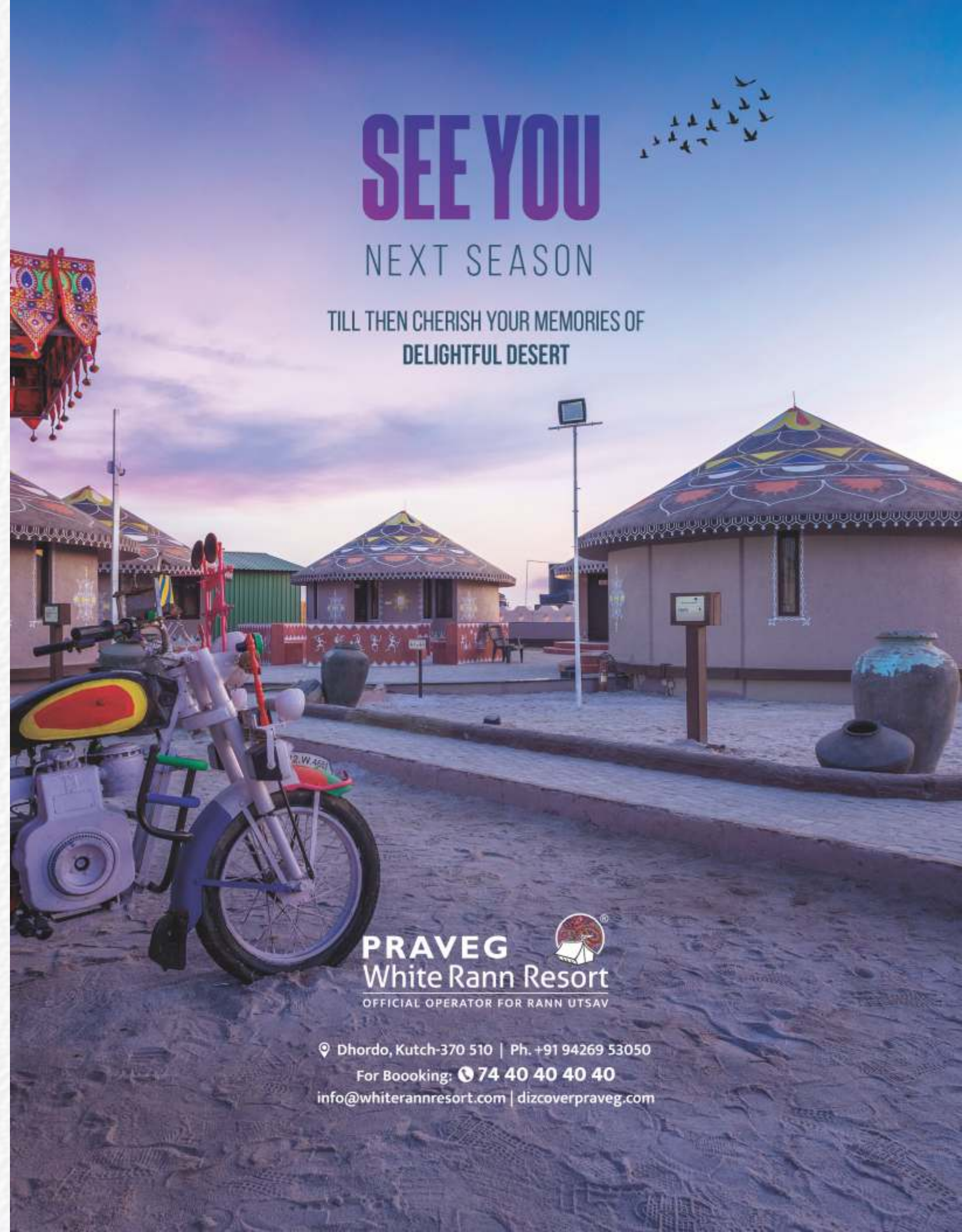
1. In a mixing bowl, combine dark chocolate chips, butter, half a teaspoon of sea salt, and cinnamon. Pour the condensed milk over the mixture and stir lightly.
  2. Microwave the bowl for about one minute until the chocolate melts. You can also melt it using a double boiler if you prefer.
  3. Stir the melted mixture gently until it becomes smooth and thick. Avoid stirring too vigorously, as it may create air bubbles.
  4. Grease a baking tin or pan with butter and line it with parchment paper or aluminium foil.
  5. Pour the chocolate mixture into the prepared pan and spread it evenly with a spatula. Sprinkle sea salt generously on top.
  6. Refrigerate the pan for a few hours or overnight until the fudge becomes firm.
  7. Once set, run a knife along the edges of the pan and lift the fudge out using the parchment paper. Place it on a cutting board and cut into generous squares.
- Enjoy this rich chocolate fudge as a delightful dessert or serve it with coffee after a special meal.
