

Asaduddin Owaisi launches AIMIM's poll campaign in Gujarat with a bang



Bharuch : AIMIM chief Asaduddin Owaisi on Sunday began his party's first poll campaign in Gujarat at Bharuch. He urged Muslims, tribals and marginalised communities to unite against the denial of rights. Notably, AIMIM has forged an alliance with Chhotubhai Vasava's

Bharatiya Tribal Party (BTP) for the local body elections in Gujarat scheduled later this month. Owaisi, while addressing the gathering at Bharuch, said that AIMIM has entered Gujarat as an alternative to people, especially Muslims, Dalits, tribals and OBCs. He also took

a dig at the BJP and Congress saying they have a "manu" and "bhajna" relationship. "Muslims, tribals and the communities who are denied rights should get united and become stronger to fight and protect our rights," the Hyderabad MP said. He said, "Our motive is not to attain success in elections only, but to protect the constitutional rights of the poor and Muslims as well as to protect the land of the tribals." Taking on the Narendra Modi-Amir Shah duo, the AIMIM chief said, "Today a media person asked me why I have come to the land of Modi and Amir Shah. I replied that Gujarat is a part of India and I am a citizen of India, I can go to any corner of the country. Gujarat will always be remembered for Gandhi. Amir Shah and Modi will not be taller than Gandhi." He also raked up the issue

of farmers' protest going on for the past two-and-a-half months. Owaisi said that the farmers' protest has disturbed the sleep of PM Modi and the BJP is worried. He said people are fed-up of "Mann Ki Baat" and it is time that the PM listens to farmers' man ki baat. Apart from the Bharuch rally, Owaisi also addressed a massive rally at Ahmedabad Riverfront on Sunday evening. He said that his arrival in Gujarat is not just for one election and he had come in 2002 with a team of 25 doctors and medicines worth 50 lakh. Owaisi said that he had then set up a medical camp at Shahalam Dargah. Owaisi also targeted Congress saying that the party is afraid of PM Modi and has no future left. Therefore, he said, it was time to counter Hindu nationalism with constitutional nationalism.

CM Rupani requests Uttarakhand CM to ensure safety of pilgrims from Gujarat



Ahmedabad : Gujarat CM Vijay Rupani has spoken to his Uttarakhand counterpart Trivendra Singh Rawat requesting the latter to immediately rescue and provide assistance to pilgrims from Gujarat who are stuck in the Himalayan state. Notably, the request from Rupani came after a glacial burst near Joshimath on Sunday triggered an avalanche and flooding along the Dhauliganga and Alaknanda rivers in

Uttarakhand's Chamoli district. CM Rupani has also instructed chief secretary Anil Mukherjee to take necessary steps in this regard for the tourists and pilgrims from the state stuck in Uttarakhand due to the natural disaster. The Gujarat Chief Minister's Office tweeted, "CM Shri @vijayrupani spoke to Uttarakhand CM Shri @tsrawat and requested him for immediate rescue and assistance for the pilgrims from Gujarat trapped in the flood situation and also directed Gujarat Chief Secretary to take necessary action in this regard."

Over 150 labourers working at the Rishiganga power project in Tapovan-Reni are missing and 10 bodies have been recovered so far, the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) said. The flash flood washed away the Rishiganga hydro

project (13.2 MW) and also partially affected the downstream project of NTPC at Tapovan. Homes along the way were also swept away as the waters rushed down the mountainsides even as many villages were evacuated and people taken to safer areas. Teams from ITBP, which has a base at Joshimath, along with units of the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) and NDRF have been deployed at the spot. IAF and Army teams have also joined the rescue operations. During the day, ITBP personnel rescued all 16 people trapped in an under-construction tunnel near Tapovan dam in Chamoli district.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved an ex-gratia of Rs 2 lakh each from PMNRF for the next of kin of those who have lost their lives due to the tragic avalanche caused by a Glacial breach in Chamoli, Uttarakhand, the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) said. The PMO also announced that Rs 50,000 would be given to those seriously injured. Earlier during the day, PM Modi had tweeted: "Am constantly monitoring the unfortunate situation in Uttarakhand. India stands with Uttarakhand and the nation prays for everyone's safety there. Have been continuously speaking to senior authorities and getting updates on NDRF deployment, rescue work and relief operations."

Gujarat reports 244 new Covid-19 cases; 355 recover, one dies



AHMEDABAD : The coronavirus infection count in Gujarat went up to 2,63,444 with the addition of 244 cases on Sunday, the health department said. As the health department claimed one more life, the state's death toll rose to 4,395, it said. A total of 355 patients got discharge from hospitals after recuperating, which increased the recovery count to 2,56,670 and improved the recovery rate to 97.43 per cent, the department said in a release. The number of active cases in Gujarat currently stands at

2,379, with 24 patients being on ventilators. India has approved the shipment of Covid-19 vaccine to Cambodia and plans to supply Mongolia and Pacific Island states, officials said on Sunday, as supplies arrived in Afghanistan - all part of the country's widening vaccine diplomacy. The glacier burst at Uttarakhand is an outcome of climate change in the Himalayan region which is warming up faster than the other mountain regions, say experts.

As 13,625 more people got vaccinated for Covid-19 across 555 booths in the state, the number of such beneficiaries grew to 5,55,179, the health department said. Vadodra continues to lead with the highest number of 75 new cases, followed by Ahmedabad with 53, Rajkot 42, and Surat 32 cases. Among other districts, Gandhinagar reported eight new cases, Mehsana seven, Jamnagar six, Kutch five, Anand four, Sabarkantha three, Kheda and Gir Somnath two each, etc. The state reported only one Covid-19 fatality in Ahmedabad, the release said. In the Union Territory of Daman, Diu and Dadra and Nagar Haveli, there is only one active case as on Sunday. Out of the total 3,370 Covid-19 cases reported so far in the UT, 3,367 have recovered, the officials said. Gujarat's Covid-19 figures are as follows: Positive cases 2,63,444, new cases 244, death toll 4,395, discharged 2,56,670, active cases 2,379, people tested so far - figures not released.

Gujarat: Fill Standard X exam forms by March 5



AHMEDABAD: The Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board (GSHSEB) has fixed March 5 as the deadline for filling Class X board examination forms. The form-filling exercise, which started from February 5, is being carried out online. The form-filling process for Class XII science students is already under way while the

schedule for Class XII general stream is yet to be announced. Sources said that it is likely to begin from February 15. The GSHSEB has started registration of schools and teachers ahead of the crucial examinations. Class X and Class XII board exams will be held from May 10 to May 25 for the academic year 2020-21, the GSHSEB announced on Wednesday. As many as 17.5 lakh students took the board exams last year and this time the board expects the number to go higher.

Congress fields 25 Muslim candidates in AMC elections; AIMIM fields 21 Muslims

Ahmedabad: Opposition Congress party has fielded 25 Muslim candidates from 12 wards in AMC election, scheduled to take place later this month. In Makampura ward, all four candidates of Congress party are Muslims. Congress had in previous AMC election in 2015 had fielded 24 Muslim candidates, of whom 20 were victorious while one Muslim candidate was victorious as independent. Congress had fielded four Muslim candidates in Makampura ward, two in Shahpur, two in Darjapur, one each in Saraspur and Rakhial, two in Khadiya, three in Jamalpur, one in Sarkhe, three in Behrampura, two in Danilimda, one in Maninagar,

three in Gomtipur and one in Vatva ward. Ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has not fielded even a single Muslim candidate in AMC election. Hyderabad based Asaduddin Owaisi's party AIMIM has fielded 21 candidates from 6 wards in Ahmedabad including 2 former women councilors of Congress party. The wards in which AIMIM has fielded candidates include Jamalpur, Khadiya, Behrampura, Gomtipur, Darjapur and Makampura. AIMIM has not fielded candidates in Danilimda ward, apparently in support of Congress candidate Shah Nawaz Khan

Ahmedabad: Four abuse, attack 2 dalit men for entering OBC locality

AHMEDABAD: Two dalit men from Vadaj were thrashed by four men for entering an OBC neighbourhood, states FIR filed with Vadaj police. Prakash Makwana, 28, a resident of Vankarvas in Nava Vadaj village, stated in his FIR that he and his friend Karan Parmar were standing outside Karan's house, which is adjacent to a Bharwad neighbourhood. Four men — Sanjay

Bharwad, Akshay Bharwad, Nikhil Bharwad and Snehal Bharwad — approached them and asked them why they were standing near Bharwadvaas. "Before we could say anything, they began telling us to go away and abusing us," Prakash stated in his FIR. He further stated that the four men began hurling caste-based abuses at them. "They told us to neither come to their vaas (neighbourhood) nor do any business in their area,"

Prakash stated in the FIR. He alleged that the four also threatened to kill them. After this, the assailants fled and the victims called the police control room. A team of Vadaj police reached the spot and filed a complaint for causing hurt, use of abusive words, criminal intimidation and abetment under the IPC, along with the charges under the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act against the four accused.

Another victim of torture in police lock-up succumbs

Rajkot: Trouble for eight cops accused in the Mundra custodial death in Kutch increased many folds as another theft accused, who was also allegedly tortured in custody last month, succumbed to injuries at a hospital in Ahmedabad on Saturday. The deceased identified as Harjog Gadhvi was picked up by cops from Pragpur Patiya on the evening of January 12 on suspicion of theft, along with one Arjan Gadhvi (24). They were allegedly tortured in police custody for over a week before

Arjan developed complications on January 19. He died before reaching the government hospital in Mundra town. According to Bhuj deputy superintendent of police J N Panchal, Harjog was also admitted to Mundra hospital after Arjan passed away. "However, as Harjog's condition became critical, he was shifted to Ahmedabad where he died on Saturday," Panchal told. "Since an offence of murder is already registered against the eight accused cops in the case, a second murder charges will
