Importance of Choosing OWN Gametes in IVF



Ahmedabad, The Indian Society of Assisted Reproduction estimates that 10-14% of the Indian population is suffering from infertility. Furthermore, the rates are much higher in the urban areas where 1 out of 6 couples are impacted. If we roughly look at the data, nearly 27.5 million Indian couples are actively trying to conceive because of infertility. Similarly, in the United States of America, 1 out of 5 (19%) heterosexual women aged 15-49 years with no prior births are unable to get pregnant. Also, about 26% out of these women have difficulty getting pregnant or carrying a pregnancy to term (impaired fecundity). The data suggest that infertility is no

longer a private sorrow. It is slowly transcending due to its structural and interpersonal ramifications. In the earlier days, women were looked upon as childbearing machines. A woman giving birth to a healthy child was considered normal. On the other hand, a woman unable to conceive or finding it difficult to get through pregnancy was frowned upon. Interestingly, the responsibility of conceiving and giving birth had always been tied to a woman. This has been a prime reason behind wedding marriages and dowry practices. Child-bearing was regarded as supreme and a scale to measure a woman's worth. Hence, infertility has been a taboo or a social stigma. (19-8)

oversubscribed 4.83 times, despite being launched in the midst of very difficult pandemic and volatile market conditions. Gujarat road accident: 3 dead, 30 injured after private bus collides with truck

Palanpur: Two bus passengers and their driver were killed and nearly 30 others injured when their vehicle hit a truck near Palanpur town in Gujarat's Banaskantha district on Sunday, police said. The accident took place around 3 am when the private luxury bus was heading from Ramsin in neighbouring Rajasthan to Ahmedabad in Gujarat.

While the truck driver was trying to park his vehicle on a roadside on a national highway near Kanodar village, around 150 km from Ahmedabad, the bus hit it from behind, an official from Palanpur police station said. Two bus passengers and the driver died on the spot. The deceased were in the age group of 35 to 40 years, he said.

Two doctors from Ahmedabad scale Mt Everest

AHMEDABAD: A doctor couple from the city became the first from India to scale Mount Everest, adding another record to their name. Dr Hemant Leuva, professor of surgery at NHI Municipal Medical College, and his wife Dr Surbhi Leuva, chief medical officer at Gujarat Vidyalaya, reached the 8,849m peak at 8.30am on Friday.

Sirish Bhandari, MD at Sardar Adversity clinic said the Leuvas are the first doctor couple to achieve the feat. Local media reported that they used the opportunity to spread the message: Save the environment. Hundreds of foreign climbers and Sherpa guides attempt to climb Mt Everest in May when weather conditions in the Himalayan peaks are most favourable for climbing. The couple in 2021 had climbed Mt Manaslu, an 8,163m peak in Nepal, which is the eighth highest peak in the world. They were also together at the Everest Base Camp twice.

Dr Hemant Leuva is founder of Mountain Movers, a group of enthusiasts who have been conducting camps for both professionals and amateurs in India and abroad for the past several years. Dr Leuva had attempted the climb at Mount Everest exactly a year ago, but bad weather prevented him from reaching the summit. Instead of losing hope, he prepared with double the vigour to ensure that he achieved his dream of becoming an "Everester".

The feat is remarkable also because the couple had tested positive in 2020 for Covid. They had worked relentlessly the entire year as

medical professionals to save lives. But their unwavering focus was on the biggest prize. "It's any mountaineer's dream to reach the highest peak of the world, but there must be a purpose for taking that step. It's like going to the mother's lap. My aim is to create awareness about saving our precious planet and precarious environment," Leuva had told TOI before his Mt Everest attempt last year. His aim is to go closer to nature to motivate the members to preserve it for the next generation and promote sustainable practices. "Several city-based doctors have also accompanied the couple in their different climbs over the years and congratulations started pouring in on social media early Saturday."

Adhia panel sets GSDP target of 38.64L cr by 2026-27

Gandhinagar: The task force led by former Union finance secretary Hasmukh Adhia has set a target of gross state domestic product (GSDP) of Rs 38.64 lakh crore (\$500 billion USD) to enhance Gujarat's contribution to achieve the central government's target of making India a \$5 trillion economy by 2026-27. Gujarat's current GSDP size is Rs 21.3 lakh crore and the target is a GDP of Rs 38.64 lakh crore by March 2027 is an extremely difficult one to achieve, say experts.

The state government had constituted a task force under the chairmanship of former union finance secretary Hasmukh Adhia to chart out a roadmap for Gujarat to enable India to become a \$5 trillion economy. In the

preface of the report, the task force said, "We need to accelerate our growth rate and achieve a share of 10% in the national GDP. This means Gujarat has to achieve GSDP of \$500 billion by FY 2026-27. This would mean that Gujarat's growth rate in the next five years has to be at a CAGR (compound annual growth rate) of 14.5% in nominal terms against the track record of 12.3% in the last decade." The state budget estimate for 2021-22 has been Rs 18.7 lakh crore and for 2022-23, it is projected to be Rs 21.3 lakh crore. Since Gujarat government's budget estimates are not growing at the rate expected by the Adhia committee, it will have to revise budget estimates drastically to meet GSDP targets.
